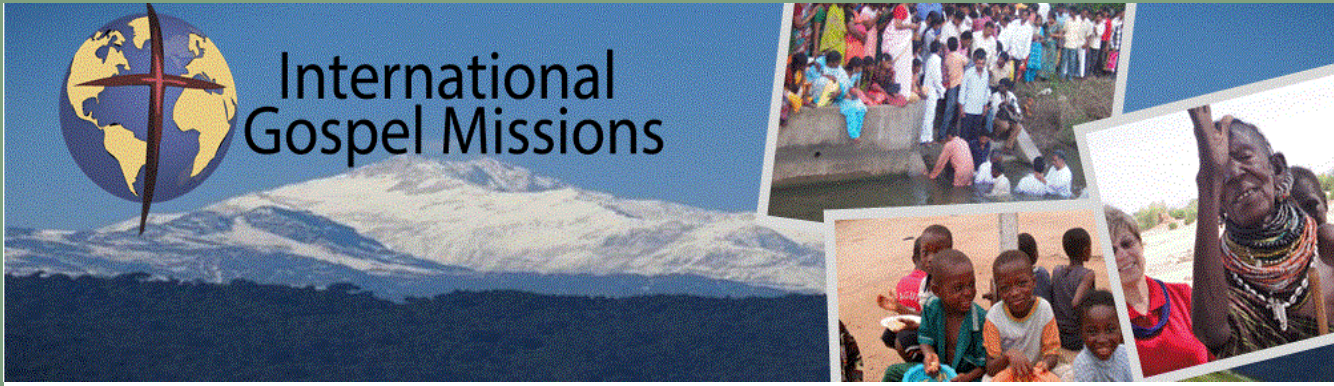

Ministry News

As you know, we are involved in church-planting and we back it up with other activities such as evangelism, child clubs, VBS, social ministries and many more. The trip to teach at Tsiko went well and Koffi is waiting for next sem to go back again to teach another course.

The Second Church at Kove-Sogbosito

Bible studies and clubs continue at Kove and we also are building a fence around the property prior to building the shelter. We lack funds to finish the fence. The back and the left side are totally done. We still need to put the fence on the right half and the front.

We do children's club on a soccer field which is located some 60 meters from the church property.

During the month of March, we were very busy distributing Samaritan's purse shoe boxes to new children. First we shared with them the Gospel using "The Greatest of All Gifts" in three different locations: at Kove on Saturday, March 4th, then on Sunday morning at Tamani and Sunday evening, March 5th at our residence. About 35 children trusted Christ as Lord and Savior. The following week, we started the three-month discipleship program with the "Greatest Journey" at all three locations.

The Easter celebration went well at both locations.

We had an outdoor evangelistic campaign in Tamani on April 6th-7th and at Kove on April 13th-14th. Pastor Rayn who is one of my assistants, preached the Gospel and out of 120 people who came, 62 of them raised their hand stood on their feet and trusted Christ as their Lord and Savior at Kove. Praise the Lord!

On Easter Sunday, Koffi baptized 4 believers and then we partook in the Lord's Supper.
