Ministry update.

The church in Togokome moved in January to Agovoudou, and attendance has been growing. Visitors come by every Sunday. The highest attendance so far is around 80 including the all-age groups.

The shelter was completed and some clean sand was spread on the floor for a cleaner look. Water well drilling also is finished and the water is available for use. Thanks to all of you who donate to make theses project possible. Shelter dedication was postponed to April 25th.

We are still dealing with the corona virus pandemic and are following guidelines set for us by the government. Vaccination has also begun. As of April 20, there are 12553 confirmed cases, 120 deaths and 10230 people recovered from Covid 19.
