Ministry News

From August 15-22, we were honored by the presence in Togo of a team of LSBC (USA) and Iglesia Biblica Amistad (Panama) who did our 2016 VBS for us. We all had a great time of ministry and fellowship. Our VBS attendance went up from 200 on the first day to over 500 on the last day and more than 150 salvation decisions were registered.

August 20 was our 5th anniversary celebration. We invited friends and neighbors to come and rejoice with us for what the Lord has done in the church in the last 5 years. In fact, you all know how we have been asked to move out of our current rental property before the end of the lease but God so graciously provided and now we have moved to Tamany where the church is growing. Pastor Jim King, who led the team from America, preached from Revelation 2 and encouraged us not to lose our first love. Then Adam Drake, who represented Salem Baptist Church, encouraged us with 2 Cor.2:15. "For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that perish." The service was well attended and was followed by a baptismal ceremony; Pastor Jim baptized 12 people. After the baptism, Koffi asked him to preach the Gospel. Following the proclamation of the Gospel, 5 people trusted Christ as Lord and Savior.

Each week, Koffi teaches twice at Faculte Baptiste de Theologie and he will be traveling to Kpalime in January to teach Old Testament Survey to some laymen and pastors who are working but strongly desire to study the Scriptures and to be used efficiently by God.

The Kove ministry continued with the Bible study on Saturday and door-to-door evangelism every other Saturday. We have finally started the children's club with a minimum attendance varying between 12 and 20 children. The land is



empty and this month we will begin to put up a wall and a shelter.

We have gotten the tablets and are so thankful for your provision to buy them. We also find the tablet very useful. On behalf of my team, we say thank you so much for providing for those tablets. They are such great resources for ministry.

We are doing well by the grace of God. Finally, Samuel is about to finish 6th grade and to start middle school. He is doing better as the year passes. Elisabeth is taking some medication for high blood pressure. Koffi was sick in September through October but now he is doing well. Thank you for your prayers.

It reminds me of my total dependence on God, and I am learning that it's worth all the hard work, sweat, sacrifice (though very little), pain, and prayers just so I can know Him a little better and to be better equipped for His work.
