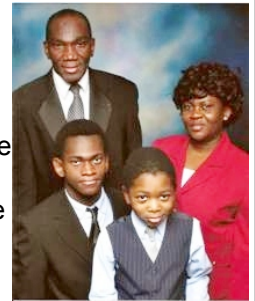

The next step is to do the floor and we are working hard to finish it this week. We have postponed our first service to February 24th in order to have enough time to finish the floor. At Christmas, we had a celebration for the children and on the afternoon of Dec 30th, leaders and family got together at our residence. It was a great time of exchange and fellowship.
