Dear Friends and Church Family,

We are thankful to the Lord for His leading in our lives and ministry. Since the purchase of the land for the church in Tamanyi, the church is rejoicing to have land. Greetings from us and from Eglise Baptiste Biblique Salem in Togo

During April through the first half of June, we continued with our weekly church activities and meetings. We taught a series of Bible lessons on the Lordship of Christ, and from Pentecost 'til now, the adult class is receiving teachings on the baptism, indwelling, sealing and filling of the Holy Spirit.



The ladies participated in a celebration of Mother's Day with other churches. About 200 ladies came. In July, our first ladies' outreach program will take place. There will be teaching on knitting and food preparation. Elisabeth is in charge of coordinating the ladies' program. The goal is to spread the Gospel. Our investigation shows that many ladies are interested as the sections are free of charge.

We have started the preparations for VBS 2015. We are expecting more than 200 children in August. About church growth, a lady who trusted Christ earlier has started attending the church and a school math teacher who moved to the area is also attending the church faithfully. We continue bus ministry at our own expenses. Some work has been done to make the church property more attractive. We got an electric power line. We are also building the children's Sunday school shelter.

The family is doing well. Koffi's foot has healed a lot. He is no longer using the canes to walk and he can put on dress shoes. Thank you for your prayers. Elisabeth has started teaching the children about faith. Two weeks ago, Samuel developed a sudden interest in leading music during church services so I decided to let him lead the songs and see. On Wednesday nights, I let him enunciate the song and he does well. Joshua is getting ready to go to Romania on July 11th for two weeks. Please pray that the Romania team from PCC would have a wonderful ministry there.
